The hotel has provided a block of rooms for our function and will hold them until September 8, 2000, or until the block fills whichever comes first. Make your reservations early by calling the DoubleTree Hotel at (800) 222-TREE. Be sure to tell them that you are attending the "CH2M HILL Retiree's Meeting." Reservations can be cancelled without penalty prior to 4:00 p.m. on day of arrival.

Many of you may know that the DoubleTree was formerly the Red Lion Hotel where several stockholders meetings were held. It's location is ideal, within easy walking distance of the Lloyd Center shopping Mall, the CH2M HILL office, MAX light rail, and the free vintage trolley line to downtown Portland.

Those needing transportation to any of the activities can sign up for rides at this time. An assortment of information regarding other interesting Portland area attractions will be available for those who may wish to extend their stay.
