
Baldwin Park receives EPA's Phoenix Award

In November 2006, the Baldwin Park project received the Phoenix Award for excellence in environmental redevelopment during the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Brownfields Conference. During the awards presentation, Baldwin Park was also recognized as one of the top two revitalization projects in the United States.

Created in 1997, the Phoenix Awards recognize excellence in brown-field redevelopment. Criteria for selection include project magnitude, innovative techniques, solutions to regulatory issues and community impact.
