


## Employees rally for Water For People

Each May for the past 6 years, CH2M HILL has participated in the Water For People Workplace Giving Campaign, an international fundraising effort to develop safe drinking water resources, improved sanitation facilities, and hygiene education programs for disadvantaged people around the world. This year, employees responded overwhelmingly, raising more than \$170,000.

A simple fact presented in a Virtual Office story hit home for many—roughly \$29 provides one person with water or sanitation for a lifetime through a Water For People project. This year, nearly 6,000 people will benefit from safe drinking water supplies and improved sanitation, thanks to the generosity of CH2M HILL employees.

Creativity helped many offices raise money. Fundraisers during this year's campaign included cake sales, barbeques, raffles, and rummage sales.

Thanks to all those who generously supported this year's Water For People Workplace Giving Campaign. 

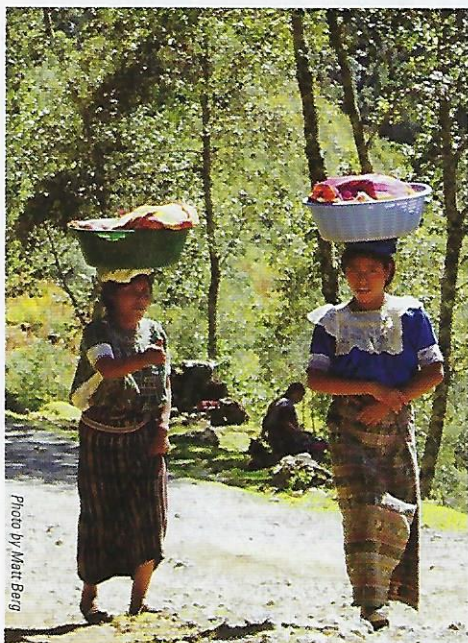
