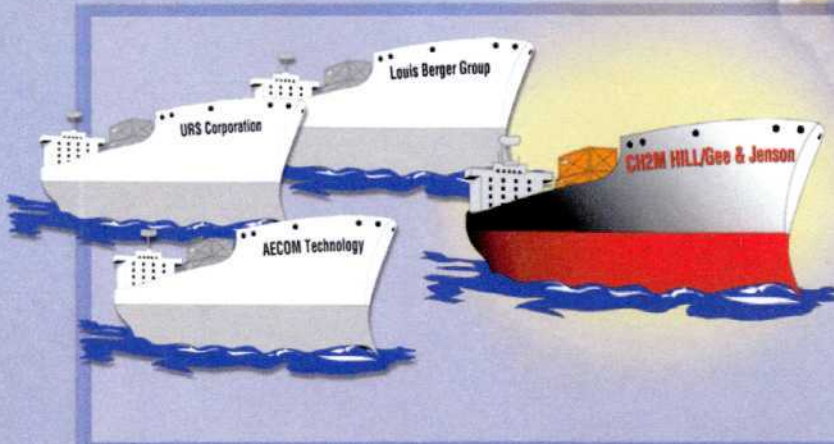

deliver projects on Atlantic, Gulf and Pacific coasts (as well as the Caribbean and overseas) there is no port in North America that CH2M HILL's expanded port practice can't serve.
