Eligibility Criteria:

- High school graduate, or expected to graduate in spring of application due date
- Admitted to, or currently enrolled in, an accredited two-year or four-year, public or private college or university
- Currently pursuing or planning to pursue a STEM curriculum in the areas of engineering, planning, environmental sciences, construction, or economics
- Must be sponsored by a current member of the CH2M HILL Alumni Association. However, the following applicants are NOT eligible to receive a scholarship award, per the terms of our 501(c)(3) certification: family members of the Board of Directors or officers of CHAA or LGFI; family members of the scholarship selection committee; or family members of major donors (i.e. \$5,000 or more) to the Legacy Gift Fund.

- 2.
