

CHAA Legacy Gift Fund Scholarship

2026 Application Form

Eligibility Criteria

- High school graduate, or expected to graduate in spring of application due date
- Admitted to, or currently enrolled in, an accredited four-year, public or private college or university in the United States
- Currently pursuing or planning to pursue an undergraduate curriculum in the areas of engineering (agricultural, biological, chemical, civil, construction, electrical, environmental, materials, mechanical, nuclear) or environmental sciences (ecology, environmental management, environmental policy, geology, marine science, sustainability).
- Must be sponsored by a current subscriber (dues-paying member) of the CH2M HILL Alumni Association. However, the following applicants are NOT eligible to receive a scholarship award, per the terms of our 501(c)(3) certification: family members of the CHAA or LGFI Board of Directors or officers of those organizations; family members of the scholarship selection committee; or family members of major donors (i.e. \$5,000 or more) to the Legacy Gift Fund.
- Past applicants who did not receive a scholarship in 2025 are eligible to apply in 2026
- If a 2025 scholarship applicant was selected, they will not be eligible to receive a scholarship again in 2026
